**Our Adoption Fee:**

**Our Adoption Fee:** Our adoption fee is £425 for puppies and dogs. If an agreement to home a dog is made a £150 non-refundable deposit will be required. If the dog is travelling from overseas to the U.K. the balance remaining after deposit of £275 is payable two weeks before the transport leaves for the U.K. **The Adoption Fee is non-refundable.**

**Overseas dogs:** All our dogs from abroad are blood tested for Leishmaniasis, micro-chipped, fully vaccinated for Parvo etc and Rabies. They are also neutered/spayed if old enough.

**UK dogs:**

Our adoption fee is £395 for puppies and dogs in the UK. If an agreement to home a dog is made a £150 non-refundable deposit will be required to secure/reserve the dog with the remaining £245 payable on delivery/collection. **The adoption fee is non-refundable.**

**If at the time of adoption the dog is too young to be neutered/spayed then the adopter/s will be required as a condition of the adoption agreement to neuter/spay the dog at their own expense and provide us with written confirmation.**

**NB:** We would welcome inclusion of a photograph of any resident dog if you have one when you return this questionnaire to us together with photographs or video of your garden.
